Walking loop

About 425 linear meters

Garbage bins

Playground for younger children

Mature tree canopy

Mainly London plane and English oak trees

Low points on the grass field

Laneway on 3 edges

Cars are often found parked between trees

Combined sanitary-storm main

Main runs below the grass field

B-grade bookable sports field

Popular with ultimate frisbee, football and touch football

Slope areas > 20%

Benches

Found along the pathway and at the top of the slope

Rolling grassy hills

Park name plaque

Attached to a low boulder

Street trees

Mainly Rosthern apple trees

GENERAL BROCK PARK

- 2.11 hectares
- Opened in 1975, named after a British General Administrator of Upper Canada and a Canadian hero at the War of 1812
- 62 trees on site; 60 in moderate health
- Gentle slope downwards from the southeast to northwest corner; sanitary main, buried stream channel on the west side moving north south
